Some theologians and spiritual authors opine that charity unites us to the three Divine Persons which are the source of all charity. The HOLY GHOST is the eternal PAST and the Spirit of Truth that unites all of us and dwells in our soul forever.

## T H E O M N I P O T E N T O N E

The first and the greatest Commandment is that the Lord our God is the most important element in the universe." There is nothing, absolutely nothing, that occupies a higher station than God.
